

## Sewn Felt Bowl

## Supplies:

- Pre-cut felt round
- Embroidery floss
- Hand sewing needle
- Scissors
- White pencil or chalk
- Paper template

## **Instructions:**

- 1. You are going to quickly turn a flat piece of felt into a cute catch all felt bowl!
- 2. Take the paper template and lay it on the felt round. Following the marks on the template, mark the felt bowl with 8 light white dashes.
- 3. Next, pick your color of embroidery floss. Cut a piece maybe 8"-10" long and knot it at the end.
- 4. Pinching the felt piece at one of the white marks, and starting from the inside of the felt "bowl", run your needle through the felt from inside to outside. Tuck the knot inside the newly formed pinched edge.
- 5. Doing a very simple whip stitch, sew the pinched corner 2-3 times, in and out of the fabric. You can go around the outside edge, or you can go over the top edge of the felt bowl. It's a stylistic choice!
- 6. When you are done, form a knot by putting the needle through your last stitch before it is pulled tight. You can do this a 2nd time if you want. Snip the end.
- 7. Move on to the other 7 pinched edges, and when you are done, put the table on a firm surface, gently push the bottom of the round into place, and you have a sweet little treasure bowl!
- 8. You can always make multiple sized bowls so they nest inside one another.
